Submission Guidelines

- Orange County regular, property owner, or fee card in good standing is required to win.
- All art for both categories must be submitted on 8 1/2 x 11 white paper. Any submission larger than this will be disqualified.
- Two categories: Character submission and Comic Strip submission.
- Comic Strip can take up both sides of paper and must have a minimum of 2 panels with a maximum of 12 panels.
- Up to 2 pieces total may be submitted per applicant.
- Each submission must contain a separate Official Entry Form which should be attached to the art.
- Please do not sign your name on the artwork.
- Artwork must be original drawings, not photocopied, reproduced, or computer generated.
- Black and white or color drawings are acceptable.
- Artwork or description that includes vulgarity, excessive violence, or material considered offensive to any religious or ethnic groups, gender, or physically or mentally challenged persons will be disqualified.
- By submission, the artist grants permission for the library to display, participant photograph and reproduce the submitted work and/or any likeness of work or participant for publicity purposes.
- All entries will become property of Orange County Library System.
- The Library will not be held responsible for lost or damaged work.
- Winners will be announced at the **Animanga Mini-Con Party**, Thursday, November 18, at 6 p.m.
- Winners will also be featured on the library's teen website, "it".
