Flood Maps for eastern Central Florida are in the Business & Science Department.

Future Land Use Maps for Orange County are located in the Planning & Local Government Collection.

Historical Maps of Florida can be found in the Florida Collection. Additional historical maps of several states and a few European countries can be found in the Genealogy Collection.

Nautical Maps for Florida, the eastern United States, the Bahamas and the Virgin Islands are in the Business & Science Department.

Orlando Urban Area Transportation Plan Maps (OUATS and Tips) are in the Planning & Local Government Collection.

Plat Maps (current) for Orange County are in the Business & Science Department. Several older plat maps for parts of Seminole County, Maitland and Winter Park are in the Florida Collection.

Road Maps can be found in the Social Science Department. Orlando and Florida maps are at the reference desk, and those for other cities, counties, states and foreign countries are in the Vertical File.
