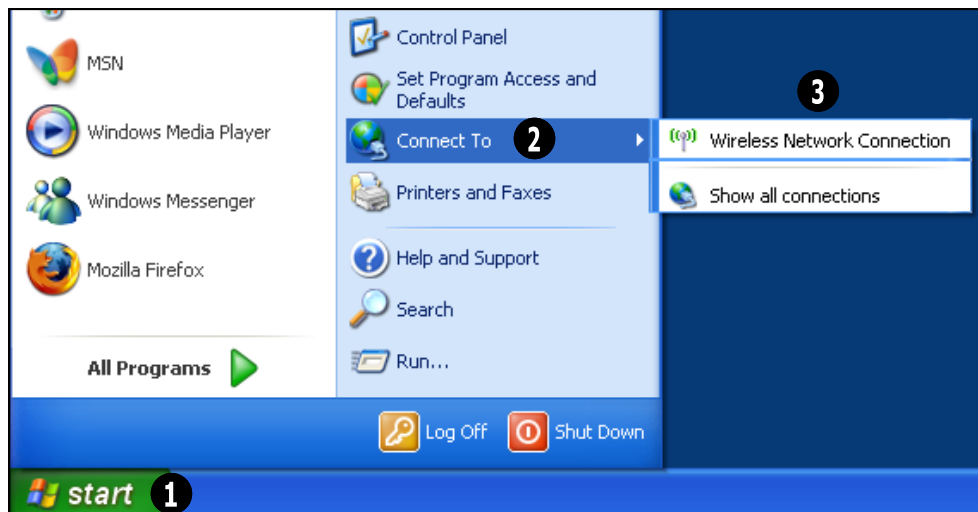


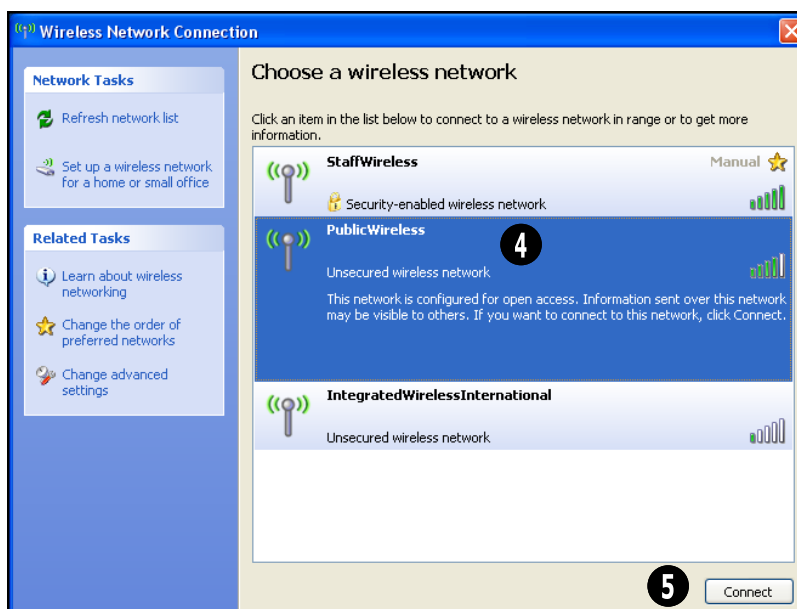
The Orange County Library System offers wireless internet access in all of our locations. To access the wireless network you must have an Orange County Library card that is in good standing or a PC Pass. In order to connect to the OCLS Wireless Network follow the two steps outlined in this tutorial.

To connect to the OCLS Wireless Network, follow the steps outlined below:

Connect to the PublicWireless Network (Windows XP)

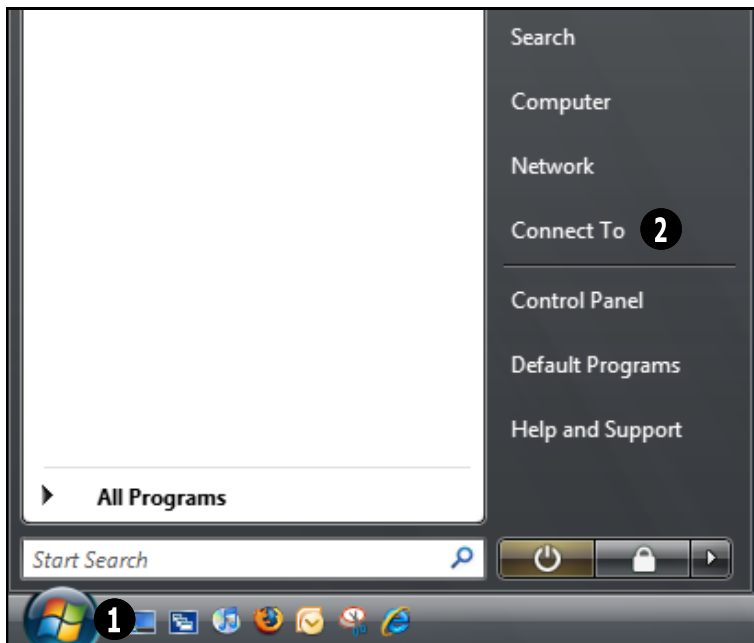


1. Click on the **Start** button.
2. Select the **Connect To** option.
3. Select the **Wireless Network Connection** option.

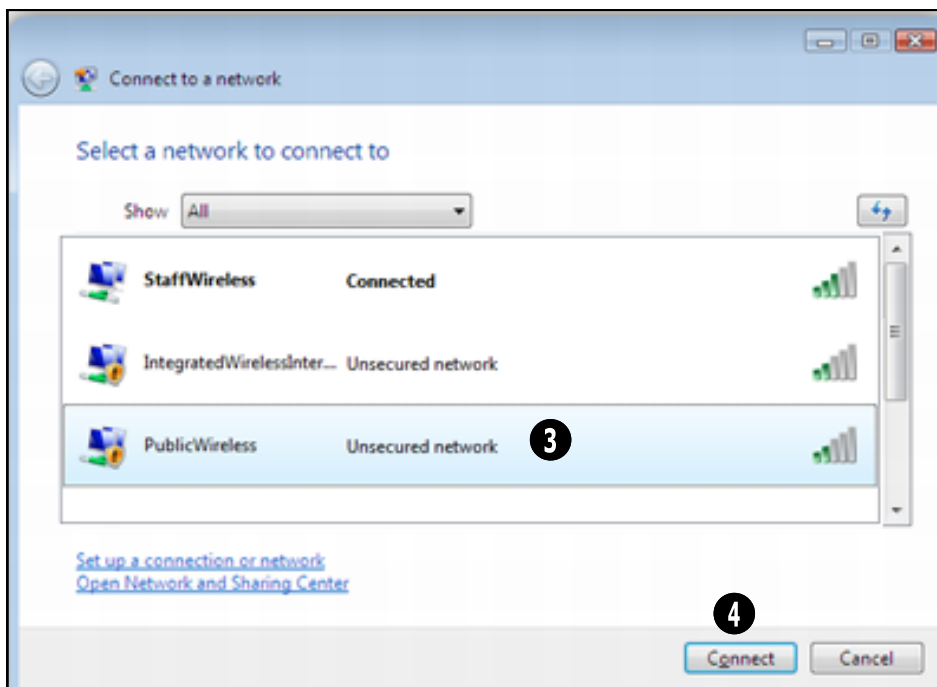


4. Select **PublicWireless** from the list of available networks.
5. Click on the **Connect** button.

Connect to the PublicWireless Network (Windows Vista)

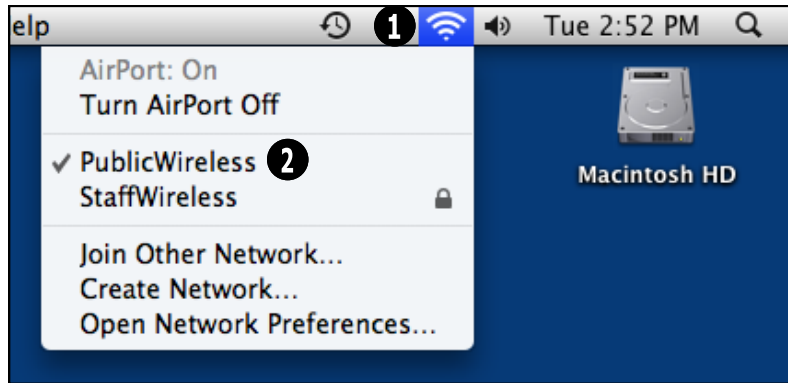


1. Click on the **Start** button.
2. Select the **Connect To** option.



3. Select **PublicWireless** from the list of available networks.
4. Click on the **Connect** button.

Connect to the PublicWireless Network (Mac OS X)



1. Click on the **AirPort Status** icon on the menu bar.
2. Select **PublicWireless** from the list of available networks.

Login to the OCLS Wireless Network



1. Launch an **Internet Browser**.
2. Enter **Library Card Number**.
3. Enter **PIN**.
4. Click **Submit**.
5. You've connected successfully.



How to Connect

Wireless Usage Rules

1. In order to access the OCLS Wireless Network, you will need an Orange County Library card that is in good standing and is cleared of all fines.
2. If you're not an Orange County Library Card Holder, and would like to get access to the wireless network, you may purchase a PC Pass at \$10 for 7 consecutive days.
3. In order to access the OCLS Wireless Network you will need your Library card number or PC Pass card number and a PIN.
