

Age Requirements in the Children's Areas and Club Central

Providing a secure environment for children and teens is a high priority of the library.

Children's Areas

The Children's Areas are dedicated to resources and services for children (birth through 17 years of age). Parents and caretakers are invited to accompany their children to the Children's Areas to participate actively in reading, programs and the selection and use of library materials. For the safety of all children, adults (18 and over) who are not accompanied by children, are to use the Children's Areas only for the purpose of retrieving materials for check out or to pull materials for research to be used in other areas of the library.

Club Central

Club Central is a place on the first floor of the Main Library designed and reserved for use by youth ages 11 through 18. It is a comfortable, inviting place created for youth to study, socialize, and have fun learning. The use of the facility and resources, including the seating, computers and AV equipment, is limited to those from 11 through 18 years of age. Other library users wanting to use Young Adult materials will be assisted in retrieving materials by staff.
