The Orlando Public Library to host two film festivals in September

ORLANDO, FL - The Orlando Public library will host two film festivals this September.

On September 15, the Melrose Center presents the first [Melrose Film Festival](#), a day of film screenings, panel discussions and Q&A sessions from filmmakers in Orlando. More than 2,000 submissions were received for the festival this past spring, ranging from short films to animated shorts to music videos. During the festival, which takes place from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., submissions will be screened, and filmmakers and guest speakers will talk about working in the film industry.

FilmFreeway teams up with the Orange County Library System on September 29 for the [One Minute Film Festival](#). Filmmakers are challenged to capture the “world we love to live in,” finding positive views of the world by showcasing inspiring and uplifting short films. The catch: all films must be under 61 seconds, and they must either be animated or filmed in live-action. Filmmakers interested in submitting work to the One Minute Film Festival must do so by August 15. The One Minute Film Festival takes place from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. on September 29. A Q&A with some of the filmmakers will follow screenings.
