Orange County Library & WUCF TV Host *Hamilton's America* Preview Screening

Orlando, Fla. – On Monday, October 17, fans of the widely popular *Hamilton: An American Musical* will have the opportunity to attend a free preview screening of the PBS documentary *Hamilton's America*, which fleshes out the process through which Tony Award winner Lin-Manuel Miranda created the musical. The documentary also includes footage from the New York production with the original cast, as well as interviews with President Barack Obama, President George W. Bush, Questlove, Jimmy Fallon, Stephen Sondheim and others.
