**New Exhibition Features Previously Unseen Photos From Orlando's History**

Beginning in February, the Orlando Public Library will host *More Than a Memory*, an exhibition of images from the collections of the Orlando Public Library and the Orange County Bicentennial Committee.

Included in this exhibition are photographs that explore the growth of Orlando before the rise of tourism in the 1970s, with highlights including the construction of the San Juan Hotel and Beacham Theatre, and the formation of the Orange County Library System.
