Searching for the Seventies: The Documerica Photography Project is a limited-run exhibit on display August 20 – October 30 at the Orange County Regional History Center. It is the product of the Documerica program, established in 1971 by the Environmental Protection Agency. Between 1972 and 1977, photographers amassed about 22,000 images throughout the United States. The exhibition culled from their work features 90 color photographs divided into three themed sections, each named for an iconic 1970s song: The Temptations' "Ball of Confusion," Sly and the Family Stone's "Everybody Is a Star" and Joni Mitchell's "Big Yellow Taxi."
